

Emirates Pilot Requirements

Here are the important criteria...

- Age: The minimum age requirement must be 18 years old.
- **Height:** The minimum height requirement is 160 cm (5'3")
- **Education:** As per the latest updates, Emirates Airlines requires its candidates to have a minimum education in high school and preferably a degree in aviation, engineering, or a similar field.
- Licenses and Certifications: The first one is the Commercial Pilot License (CPL) which is
 a foundational license required for all commercial pilots. Another one is Instrument Rating
 (IR) it is essential for flying under instrument flight rules. Lastly is the Type Rating (TR)
 which specifies the type of aircraft you wish to fly.
- Minimum Flight Hours: A pilot needs to have at least 3000 hours of flying experience when opting for command positions and 1500 hours for multi-engine jets. Having a multicrew experience is also highly valued.
- **Flying Experience:** Type ratings on Boeing 777 or Airbus A380 are highly advantageous since these are the main aircraft in Emirates' fleet.
- **Medical Fitness:** All pilots must hold a valid Class 1 medical certificate. This ensures you meet the stringent physical and mental health standards required for the role.
- English Proficiency: English proficiency to ICAO Level 5 or higher.
- **Soft Skills:** Attaining a positive attitude at work, working like a team player, having effective problem-solving skills and an awareness of cultural sensitivity is a good thing that helps you put up a great professional character that can work in your favor.
- Visa and Relocation: Must be willing to relocate to Dubai, UAE.
