

Royal Caribbean Cruise Job Requirements

Here are the important criteria...

- **Age Requirement**: You must be at least 21 years old for most positions. Some entry-level roles may accept candidates aged 18 and above.
- **Valid Passport**: Since you'll be traveling to multiple international destinations, a valid passport with at least six months of validity is essential.
- Work Visa & Seafarer Documents: Depending on your nationality and the ship's itinerary, you may need a C1/D visa (for U.S. waters) or a Seaman's Book. Royal Caribbean often assists successful candidates in obtaining the necessary documents.
- **Medical Fitness**: A pre-employment medical exam is mandatory. Cruise ship jobs require you to be physically fit, as they involve standing for long periods and handling emergencies if needed.
- **Fluency in English**: Since English is the primary working language onboard, strong communication skills are essential. Additional language skills are a plus, especially for guest-facing roles.
- **Relevant Experience**: Prior experience in hospitality, customer service, or the maritime industry is preferred.
- **Medical Fitness**: Candidates must pass a pre-employment medical examination to ensure they meet health standards.
- **Background Check**: A clean criminal record is necessary, as all applicants undergo background checks.
